### **Guest Presenter: Leslie Leong**

The Club is pleased to welcome guest presenter Leslie Leong on February 2, 7PM at the Whitehorse Public Library:

"Leslie Leong (b. 1962, Vancouver, BC) is a multi-disciplinary visual artist living and working in Whitehorse, Yukon. After 20 years in the North, she is deeply affected by northern culture, society and environment, and the relationships between them.

Her art practice began with photography as a full-time career in 1994. She has produced two bestselling photographic books: Canada's Northwest Territories. a land of diversity; and Our Forgotten North, a glimpse of the sub-arctic in Canada's north.

She has exhibited internationally with over 15 solo exhibitions and many group exhibitions and has taught in the Northwest Territories and Yukon."

In addition to discussing how the human eye sees vs how a camera sees, Leslie will also speak about her composition techniques and show her work.




