Fun With Flowers

The November 13 meeting will be an active session so be ready to bring your cameras and have some fun playing.

I'll bring the flowers. We'll focus on photographing flowers in creative ways. Some examples are: multiple exposures, adding light with flashlights or speedlights/modifiers Intentional Camera Movement; adding water droplets, using filters, and different backgrounds.

What I will bring: flowers (though if anyone can add a few flowers that would be appreciated), flashlights, spray bottles, black cardboard backgrounds, a speedlight, funnels for directing light, various other light sources (fair lights, etc.), filters such as wax paper, saran wrap, and whatever else I can think of.

What you need to bring: Camera, tripod, anything to enhance your flower-photographing experience such as lighting sources, spray bottles, backgrounds, small mirrors - anything on my list that can help such as additional backgrounds and filters. If you can bring stands and vases to hold the flowers that would be great as I don't have many.

Also bring: your creativity and willingness to help each other.
